- Committee Chairs and Co-Chairs have the final decision on which members they select to join their committee.
- After 1-2 years of service on a committee, you may be recommended for the Committee Chair or Co-Chair position.
- Committee Chair recommendations are made and reviewed by the ACG Houston Board of Directors.
- Committee Chairs can only serve for 2 consecutive years.
- A minimum of 2-3 years of ACG service is required before you are considered for a seat of the Board. There are several other factors considered such as length of membership, level of engagement within ACG, primary function, etc.
